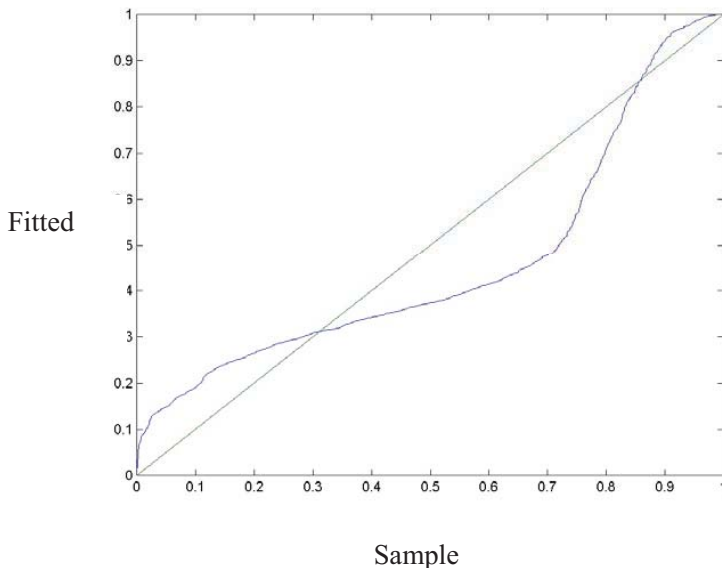


59. The graph below shows a p - p plot of a fitted distribution compared to a sample.
